- The Kids Club accepts children aged 6 weeks to 12 years of age.
- There is a 2-hour time limit, per day, per child. If a parent or guardian exceed the 2-hour time limit, documentation will be provided to P/G. Late fee of \$5.00 per child incurs after 2-hour time limit. Repeated offenders will lose access to Kids Club privileges.
- Child(ren) must be dropped off and picked up by the same P/G. There are no exceptions.
- P/G must remain within the fitness center while any children are checked in to the Kids Club. Any P/G who leave the premises will have access revoked.
 - If you find yourself witness to a child being left in the Kids Club while the P/G is off-premises, report this to your GM or OM.
- P/G must provide a receipt as proof of payment for their daily visit if their monthly membership plan does not include Kids Club access. (\$5.00 per day, per child.)
- P/G is encouraged to take their child(ren) to the restroom before leaving them in the care of the Kids Club. Staff is prohibited from accompanying any child(ren) to the restroom, as well as prohibited from diaper changes. P/G will be contacted should their child(ren) need to use the restroom during their stay.
- Children are not permitted to enter the Kids Club if they are ill or have head lice.
 - Illnesses include, but are not limited to: Chicken pox, flu, cold, diphtheria, gastroenteritis, hepatitis type A, impetigo, measles, meningitis, mumps, pink eye, polio, ring worm, scabies, shigellosis, strep throat, scarlet fever, tuberculosis, whooping cough, COVID, hand/mouth/foot infection.
- Every effort is made to comfort a crying child. If a child cannot be calmed within 15 minutes, staff will contact the P/G to assist or remove the child.
- Children who exhibit disruptive behavior such as, but not limited to: Hitting, pushing, biting, fighting, abusive language, or disobeying other Club rules will be written up using the Disruptive Behavior Violation Chart.
- Staff will communicate with P/G to keep them informed of their child(ren)'s behavior. If there is an incident, P/G will be notified upon pickup.
- If a child is injured while in the Kids Club, an incident report will be filled out by attending Staff and signed by both the Manager and P/G.
- In the event of serious injury, P/G is notified immediately and 911 called (if necessary)
- No personal toys, electronics, food, or drinks are allowed.
 - Bottles and sippy cups with water are permitted.
- For their safety, all children must arrive fully dressed, including shirt and shoes.
- TruFit is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- Failure to follow the rules and regulations will result in the loss of Kids Club privileges.
